

After receiving an undergraduate degree in chemistry from Willamette in 2000, Dave Rigsby worked for four years in research and development for Intel as a member of the ion implant team. In spring 2004, Dave returned to his alma mater and has held numerous leadership positions at the university, including Associate Dean of Campus Life, Director of Athletics and his current position as Associate Vice President of Advancement. During his tenure in Campus Life (student affairs), Dave helped lead efforts related to the programming, design and construction of the Kaneko Commons. Dave also helped create Willamette's first threat assessment program and also served as interim Director of Career Services.
